Regular Election vs. Special Election

Regular Elections

- Held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of each odd-numbered year
- Held to elect qualified persons to membership on a local governing body, such as a school board
- Nonpartisan election (no party or slate)
- May include a ballot question (bond or mill levy)
- Called, conducted, and canvassed pursuant to the Election Code
 - Early/Absentee voting
 - Physical polling locations on election day

Regular Election vs. Special Election



Held at any time other than a regular election

3

- More than 70 days before any statewide election
- 100 days or more after a general or regular local election

70 days or more after a primary or U.S. representative election

- Called, conducted, and canvassed pursuant to the Special Election Act
 - Mail ballot only
 - District bears expense

Election Countdown-June

5

- Saturday, June 5, 2021 First day for District to notify County Clerk of all board positions and position numbers to be filled at November 2, 2021 Regular Local Election [NMSA 1978, § 1-22-4(A)]
- Notice may be submitted by Board or Superintendent.
- Include positions that were filled by appointment since 2019 election and all positions expiring December 31, 2021.
- Include HB 33 or SB 9 mill levy or bond questions now, if possible (even though deadline is not until Tuesday, August 24, 2021)

Election Countdown-July

- Monday, July 5, 2021 Last day for District to notify County Clerk of all board positions and position numbers to be filled at November 2, 2021 Regular Local Election [NMSA 1978, § 1-22-4(A)]
- If you have really been snoozing, email or walk it in to each County Clerk's office where your district has voting precincts.

Election Countdown-July County Clerk & Secretary of State Duties

Tuesday, July 13, 2021 Last day for County Clerk to notify Secretary of State of all board member positions to be filled at November 2, 2021 Regular Local Election [NMSA 1978, § 1-22-4(A)]

Thursday, July 15 - Last day to notify DFA, local government division of intent to place the question of imposing or renewing a mill levy on the November 2nd Regular Local Election ballot. § 7-38-36.2.

Election Countdown-August County Clerk & Secretary of State Duties

- Wednesday, August 4, 2021 Secretary of State shall issue and file a proclamation in English and Spanish calling 2021 Regular Local Election [NMSA 1978, § 1-22-4(B)]
- After receipt from Secretary of State, County Clerk shall post entire election proclamation in English and Spanish on County Clerk's website [NMSA 1978, § 1-22-4(D)]

Note: Secretary of State is responsible for preparing regular election translations

Election Countdown-August County Clerk & Secretary of State Duties

Thursday, August 19, 2021 <u>Deadline</u> for County Clerks to publish portions of election proclamation in English and Spanish in a newspaper of general circulation within County (or Counties for multi-county Districts) [NMSA 1978, § 1-22-4(D)]

10

Publication must conform to requirements of federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended.

Election Count Down-August Ballot Questions

Monday, August 23, 2021 Last day for Boards to adopt Resolution Proposing HB 33, SB 9 mill levy or bond ballot question for November 2nd Regular Local Election. [NMSA 1978, §§ 1-16-2 and 1-16-3]

Note: Begin planning voter education steps for mill and bond elections

Election Countdown-August Ballot Questions

Tuesday, August 24, 2021 Deadline for filing Board Resolution authorizing Regular Local Election ballot questions with County Clerk of each county containing voting precincts [NMSA 1978, § 1-16-3(B)]

Election Countdown-August Candidate Declarations

Tuesday, August 24, 2021 <u>Deadline</u> of between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. to file Declarations of Candidacy with office of the County Clerk in each county with voting precincts [NMSA 1978, § 1-22-7(A)]

- Note, the (1) the declarant must personally file or give written authorization for another person to file on behalf of the declarant; and (2) the declaration must be filed in all counties with voting precincts in your District.

Friday, August 27, 2021 <u>Deadline</u> for County Clerk to certify all mill and bond ballot questions to Secretary of State [NMSA 1978, § 1-16-3(B)]

Election Countdown-August Write-Ins and Withdrawals

Tuesday, August 31, 2021 <u>Deadline</u> of between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. to file Declaration of Candidacy for write-in candidate with office of the County Clerk [NMSA 1978, § 1-22-8.1(C)]

Tuesday, August 31, 2021 <u>Deadline</u> to withdraw as candidate [NMSA 1978, § 1-10-6(C)]

Election Countdown-September Candidate Notice

- Friday, September 3, 2021 <u>Deadline</u> of 5:00 p.m. for County Clerk to:
 - (1) determine qualifications of and place qualified candidate's name for position qualified candidate declared on ballot, and
 - (2) notify qualified candidate that name will appear on ballot [NMSA 1978, § 1-22-10(A)]

Election Countdown-September Federally Qualified Ballots

Friday, September 17, 2021 <u>Deadline</u> for County Clerk to have access to ballots to send to federally qualified electors [NMSA 1978, § 1-10-5]

Election Countdown-September All Other Ballots Printed



Thursday, September 23, 2021 Deadline for County Clerk to have all other printed ballots in possession [NMSA 1978, § 1-10-5]

Election Countdown-October19Voter Registration and Early Voting

- Tuesday, October 5, 2021 <u>Deadline</u> to register to vote in Regular Local Election [NMSA 1978, § 1-4-8(A)]
- Tuesday, October 5, 2021 Absentee voting begins [NMSA 1978, § 1-6-5(F)]
- Tuesday, October 5, 2021 Early voting begins [NMSA 1978, § 1-6-5.7(A)]
- Note: Put the ballot on your website with polling place information

Election Countdown-October 20 County Clerk Publications

- Tuesday, October 12, 2021 First day for County Clerk's publication of notice of election [NMSA 1978, § 1-11-3(A)]
- Tuesday, October 26, 2021 Last day for County Clerk's publication of notice of election [NMSA 1978, § 1-11-3(A)]
- Note: The notice of election must be printed in English and Spanish and also must be broadcast on a radio station in the appropriate Native American languages in those counties affected by the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended.

Election Countdown-October 21 Early Voting Ends

Saturday, October 30, 2021 Last day to vote Early [NMSA 1978, § 1-6-5.7(A)]

Election Day



 Tuesday, November 2, 2021 Election Day
Polls open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. for in person voting.

Post Election Canvass Deadlines

- Monday, November 8, 2021 First day for county canvassing board (the County Commission) to:
 - (1) meet to approve the report of the canvass of the returns;
 - (2) declare the results of the election and of all ballot questions affecting only precincts within the county, and
 - (3) issue a certificate of canvass of the results of the election [NMSA 1978, §§ 1-13-13(A), (B), and (C)]

Post Election Canvass Deadlines

- Monday, November 8, 2021 First day for County Commission to send one copy of canvass of the results of the election to:
 - ► (a) the County Clerk,
 - (b) each local government with a candidate or ballot question (including the School District),
 - ► (c) the Secretary of State,
 - ► (d) the State Records Center, and
 - (e) the State Canvassing Board [NMSA 1978, §§ 1-13-13(A), (B), and (C)]

Post Election Canvass Deadlines

Friday, November 12, 2021 Last day for county canvassing board (the County Commission) to complete canvassing duties (see prior deadline) [NMSA 1978, §§ 1-13-13(A), (B), and (C)]

Note: For counties with more than 150,000 voters, the <u>deadline</u> is Monday, November 15, 2021

Post Election Superintendent Alert

- Between Monday November 15 and Friday, November 19, 2021 Suggested dates for publication of results of election if ballot included a bond question [NMSA 1978, § 22-18-10]
- Note: Superintendent must publish election results of bond elections in each county with voting precincts. This starts the clock for the statute of limitations on election contests.

Post Election Secretary of State Certificates

Friday, November 26, 2021 First day for Secretary of State to issue certificates of election to appropriate candidates [NMSA 1978, § 1-13-16(C)]

Saturday, January 1, 2022 Terms of office begin for elected candidates [NMSA 1978, § 1-22-18]
